From Tacoma and Seattle:

- Interstate 5 to Exit 116, Mounts Road/Old Nisqually, at end of ramp turn LEFT onto
- Nisqually Rd (Old Pacific HWY) stay on it until it ends, turn LEFT onto
- Hwy 510 (St. Clair Cut-Off Rd SE), travel 1/4 mile, turn RIGHT onto
- Meridian, travel South several miles through the stop sign at Yelm HWY,
- Continue on Meridian through a left turn and a right turn,
- When you see the 20 mph turn LEFT onto
- Evergreen Valley Rd, travel approximately 1/3-mile, Fido's Farm is on the RIGHT.

From Portland:

- Interstate 5 Exit 101 Tumwater Blvd, turn east, RIGHT onto
- Tumwater Blvd SW, travel about 1.5 miles until it ends, turn LEFT onto
- Henderson Blvd, travel about 1.5 miles, turn RIGHT at stop light onto
- Yelm Highway, travel east about 7 miles, turn (76 station) RIGHT onto
- Meridian and follow it south through a left turn and a right turn.
- When you see the 20-mph sign turn LEFT onto
- Evergreen Valley Rd, travel approximately 1/3-mile, Fido's Farm is on the RIGHT.

General rules:

- Time 25 minutes
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on
- Ties: First tie-breaker is element 6. Second tie breaker is Element 5. Third tie breaker is time.

Starting set up:

- 25 sheep in Cattle Alley
- All gates are closed

1. Take Pen and Controlled Movement – 10 points

Time begins when the handler opens the gate into Cattle Alley. Gather sheep through Clover Gate Box into Clover Field.

2. Fetch/Wear and freestanding obstacle – 15 points

Exercise begins when the gate into Clover is closed. Move sheep through panel A then through panel gap B. Exercise ends when last sheep exits panel gap B

3 Road -- 10 points

Move sheep onto Road by passing through panels C. Halt and hold flock at Cone A. Exit road through panels D. Exercise ends when last sheep exits panels D.

4. Free standing panels and controlled movement– 10 points

Move sheep through Panels E then to Cone B.

5. Drive/ wear and graze– 15 points

Move sheep into marked graze. Settle sheep within graze for 1-3 minutes as called by judge.

RLF I – Handler may move with the sheep throughout the Exercise

RLF II – Handler may move to Cone C while dog drives sheep into graze

RLF III – Handler remains at Cone B until sheep enter graze

6. Gather and freestanding obstacle -- 15 points

When graze is completed position dog at the appropriate post for the dog's level. Gather sheep from the graze to Cone B. Move sheep through Panels B and then Panels A.

RLF I – The dog will be at Cone C. The Handler may move to within 15' of the sheep

RLF II – The dog will be at Cone B. The Handler may move to Cone C

RLF III – Dog and handler at Cone B

7. Shed (RLF III only) 10 points

Move flock into open area. Divide flock in half and keep them apart until judge calls your shed.

8. Controlled Movement and Reopen – 15 points

Exercise begins when last sheep exits Panel A. (Levels I & II) or judge calls shed (RLF III).

Move sheep to Clover gate, then into Entry Alley. The dog will hold the sheep away from the gates while they are opened. Time ends when the Entry Alley gate is closed.
