TRIAL INFORMATION: Draw for run order will be after trial registration closes. Bitches in heat will run in order of draw, but must be crated and exercised away from the competition. Overflow judges may be hired and the limit of runs per day as well as judging assignments may change. All breeds recognized by ASCA as herding breeds are eligible to enter the trial. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock; replacement cost will be determined at fair market value. Handlers meeting at 7:00, trial starts at 7:30 AM. Day of entries taken 6:30-7:00 AM. 3 head of calves, 3-5 head of hair cross sheep for Advanced and Open, 3-5 head of dairy goats for Started. 5 head of Geese.

Exhibitors will be notified of changes and/or cancellations via email.

Maximum of 50 runs per judge on all combined stock runs. .

Based on entries, the above listed limits may change and judging assignments may change. Any changes will be posted at the Trial Registration Desk in advance of the Trial starting.
