**FIRE:** Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.

**THUNDERSTORMS & LIGHTNING:** Should lightning be observed, all personnel and animals should move or be moved to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.

**MASS DISASTER PLAN - TORNADO:** In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.

### GENERAL

- This trial will be run under ASCA rules and regulations (<http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/>).
- All ASCA recognized herding breeds are welcome in the Farm and Stockdog Trials.
- To receive title certifications, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number (<http://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/sites/35/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>).
- WASCO reserves the right to substitute a judge, if necessary.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Owners/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing.
- WASCO, its' officers and members, ASCA, its Board of Directors and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child or spectator. Knowing this, you assume full liability for yourself, your dog and any minors under your control and accept full responsibility for any damage caused by you and/or your dog.
- The show site will open at 6:00am each day and close following judging each day. No dogs may be left at the show site overnight.
- Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!
- If you would like a place to sit, please bring your chair.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the event site.

### ENTRIES & FEES

- All entries must be on ASCA entry forms with proper fees included (<http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/>).
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the ASCA Rules & Regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Entries must have clearly visible USPS postmark. No meter mail allowed. No telephone, facsimile, email or incomplete entries will be accepted.
- Pre-entries postmarked before March 22, 2019 will not be accepted. Pre-entries close April 27, 2019.
- Entries received without proper signature, fees, information, post-dated checks, etc. will be deemed incomplete and will not be accepted as valid entries. Entry fee must be paid by check, cashier's check or money order with funds drawn on a U.S. Bank.
- WASCO will deposit entry fees on or about May 5, 2019. Any checks returned for insufficient funds will be considered a void entry. There is a \$50 service charge for returned checks. If entries are resubmitted, payment must be in the form of money order or cashier's check.
- Cancellation of entries must be in writing and postmarked or emailed no later than April 27, 2019 to receive full refund. Refunds will be issued no later than May 20, 2019. No refunds will be given for cancellations made after close of pre-entries unless run is filled from waitlist.
- No entry will be accepted from persons or dogs not in good standing with ASCA.
- The entry limit will be accepted in postmark order. If the trial is full the dog will be put on a waitlist in order of receipt.
- Confirmation of entries will be made via e-mail after entries close, on or about May 5, 2019.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified by a judge, or barred from competition by the trial committee. Entry fees will be refunded if dog is excused in writing by a veterinarian. Entry fees will not be refunded if the show/trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God, public emergencies, acts of public enemy, strikes or other causes beyond the control of WASCO.

**CATTLE FARM TRIAL**, 20 minutes with warnings at 10 and 3 minutes  
 All tasks must be attempted in order listed. Ties broken by Sort than Gather.

Starts with gate between Alley and Pen 4 open and stock in Pen 1

Pen #1 – Move stock from Pen 1 to Pen 4 for 7 pts

Pen #2 – Move stock from Pen 4 to Pen 3 for 6 pts

Sort – Sort 3 marked head to Pen 4 (sort direction at handler's discretion),  
 reunite all stock in Pen 3 for 25 pts

Pen #3 – Move stock from Pen 3 to Pen 4 for 6 pts

Chute – Move stock from Pen 4 into Chute, hold stock in Chute for inspection than release to Arena for 20 pts

Advanced handler sprays for parasites

Open handler inspects stock

Additional Task #1 - Move stock to feed bunker, dog holds stock off feeder while handler dispenses feed,

call dog off and move to cone while stock eat for 20 pts

Advanced handler must dispense feed and move 25' away from feed bunker before calling dog off

Open handler may call dog off anytime after feed is dispensed

Gather – Dog must leave from cone to gather stock to Pen 5 for 20 pts

Advanced handler must stay at cone until dog is sent

Open handler may move up halfway to stock

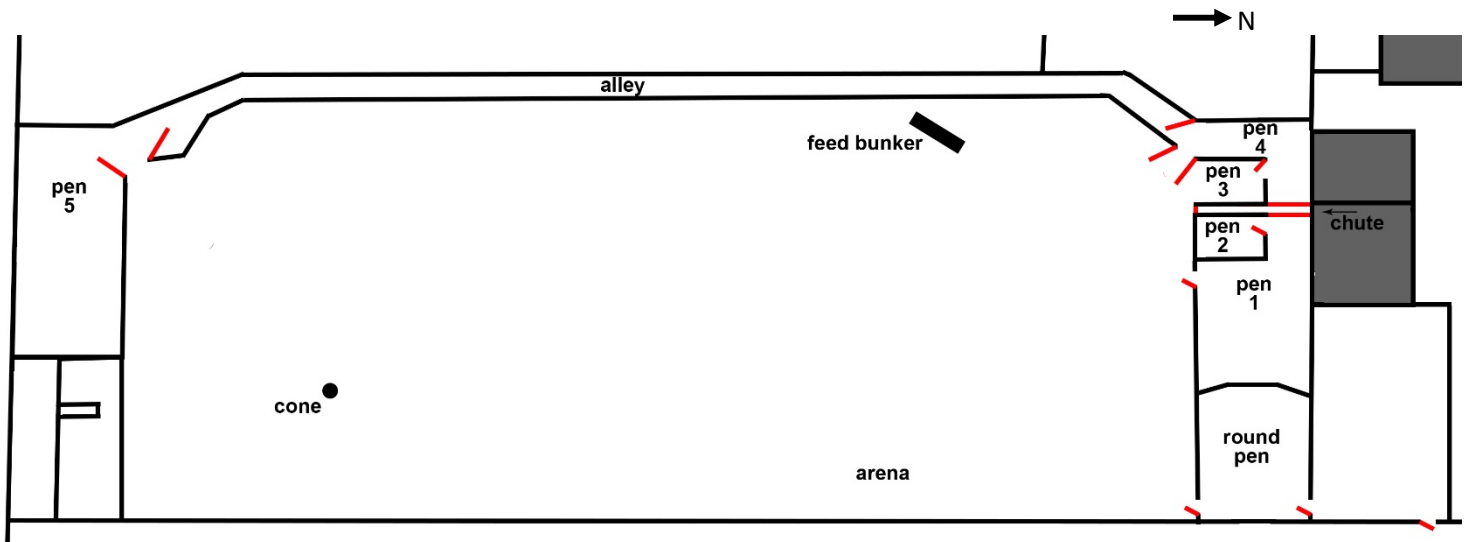
Pen #4 – Move stock from Pen 5 to Alley for 6 pts

Additional Task #2 - Move stock from Alley to Pen 4 for 20 pts

Advanced handler must remain at south end of Alley until stock passes feed bunker

Open handler may move anywhere

Finishes with stock in Pen 4 and all gates including chute front and back closed

Chute – 30' long x 2' wide

Alley – 300' x 6'

Round Pen – 30' x 40' with 4' gate to Walk-Thru Pen and 4' gate to Arena

Pen 1 – 30' x 40' with 12' x 12' dogleg behind Pen 2, 12' opening to Chute, 4' gate to Pen 2 and 4' gate to Arena

Pen 2 – 18' x 12'

Pen 3 – 18' x 12' with 4' gate to Pen 4 and 12' gate to Arena

Pen 4 – 30' x 12' with 12' x 12' dogleg behind Pen 3, 6' gate to Alley, 10' gate to Arena and 12' opening to Chute

Pen 5 – 30' x 80' with 10' gate to Arena and 10' gate to Alley

**SHEEP FARM TRIAL**, 15 minutes with warnings at 7 and 3 minutes  
 All tasks must be attempted in order listed. Ties broken by Sort than Gather.

Starts with all gates closed and stock in Pen 1

Pen #1 – Move 5 head of stock from Pen 1 into Pen 2 for 6 pts

Pen #2 – Move 5 head of stock from Pen 2 into Arena for 7 pts

Additional Task #1 – Move stock to feed bunker, dog holds stock off feeder while handler dispenses feed, call dog off and move to cone while stock eat for 20 pts  
 Advanced handler must dispense feed and move 25' away from feed bunker before calling dog off  
 Open handler may call dog off anytime after feed is dispensed

Gather – Dog must leave from cone to gather stock to Chute for 20 pts

Advanced handler must stay at cone until dog is sent

Open handler may move up halfway to stock

Chute – Move stock into Chute, doctor/inspect stock and release into Arena for 20 pts

Advanced handler sprays for parasites

Open handler inspects stock

Sort – Sort 3 marked head from Arena to Pen 2 (sort direction at handler's discretion),

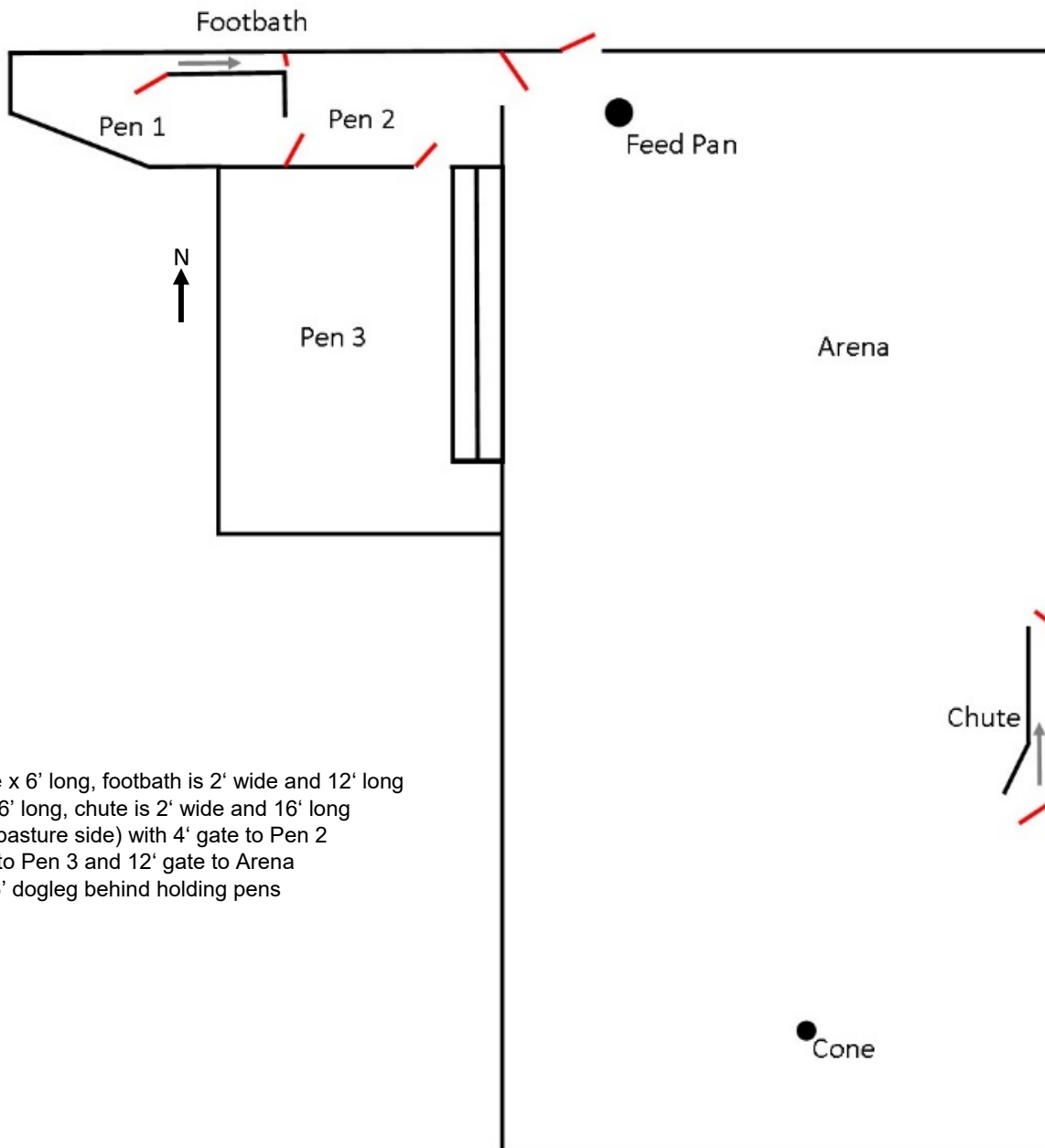
reunite all stock in Pen 2 for 25 pts

Pen #3 – Move stock from Pen 2 to Pen 1 for 6 pts

Additional Task #2, Footbath – Move stock from Pen 1 through Footbath and release into Pen 2 for 20 pts

Pen #4 – Move stock from Pen 1 to Pen 3 for 6 pts

Finishes with stock in Pen 3 and all gates including chute front and back closed

Arena – 100' x 200'

Footbath – entrance is 6' wide x 6' long, footbath is 2' wide and 12' long

Chute – entrance is 6' wide x 6' long, chute is 2' wide and 16' long

Pen 1 – 25' x 16' (narrows at pasture side) with 4' gate to Pen 2

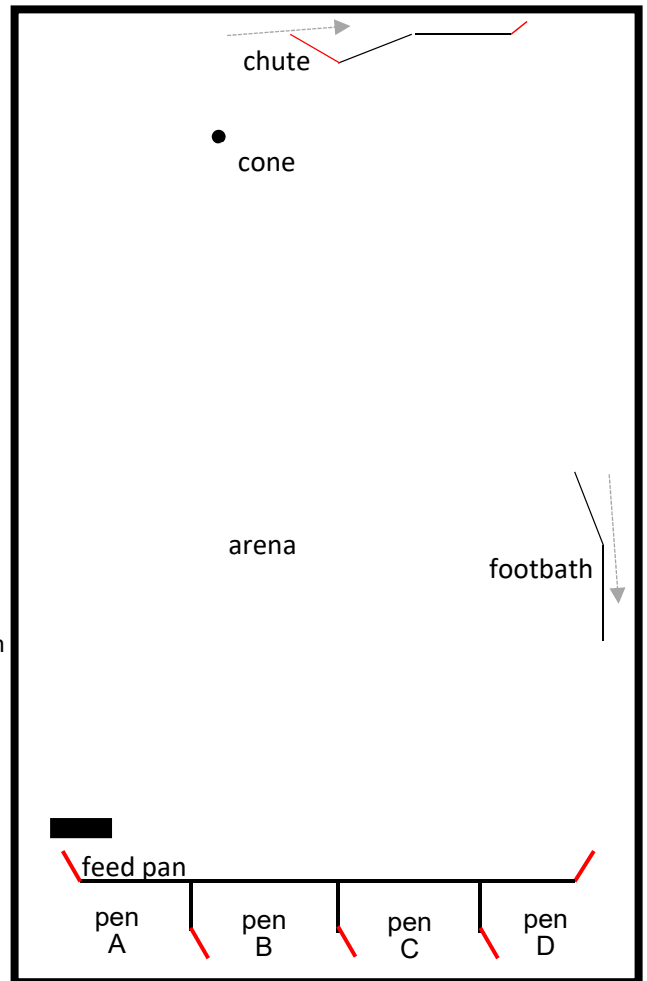
Pen 2 – 25' x 16' with 4' gate to Pen 3 and 12' gate to Arena

Pen 3 – 32' x 50' with 12' x 16' dogleg behind holding pens

**DUCK FARM TRIAL**, 12 minutes with warnings at 6 and 3 minutes  
All tasks must be attempted in order listed. Ties broken by Sort than Gather.

- Starts with all gates closed, small amount of feed in feed pan and stock in Pen D
- Sort – Sort 3 marked head from Pen D to Pen C (sort direction at handler's discretion), reunite all stock in Pen D for 25 pts
- Pen #1 – Move stock from Pen D to Pen C for 5 pts
- Pen #2 – Move stock from Pen C to Pen B for 5 pts
- Pen #3 – Move stock from Pen B to Pen A for 5 pts
- Pen #4 – Move stock from Pen A to feed pan in Arena call dog off stock and move to cone for 10 pts
- Gather – Dog must leave from cone to gather stock to Chute for 20 pts  
Advanced handler must stay at cone until dog is sent  
Open handler may move up halfway to stock
- Chute – Move stock into Chute and hold for inspection, release into Arena for 20 pts  
Advanced handler sprays for parasites  
Open handler inspects stock
- Additional Task #1 Footbath – Move stock through Footbath and exhaust into Pen D for 20 pts  
Advanced handler stays behind Footbath exit until stock exits footbath  
Open handler may move anywhere
- Additional Task #2 – Move Crate into Pen area and load stock into Crate for 20 pts
- Finishes with stock in Crate and all gates closed

- Arena – 60' x 90'
- Pens A, B, C, D – 15' x 8'
- Chute – 4' opening x 4' long entrance, 2' wide x 8' long chute

- Footbath – 4' opening x 4' long entrance, 2' wide x 4' long footbath



**MIXED FARM TRIAL**, 14 minutes with warnings at 7 and 3 minutes  
All tasks must be attempted in order listed. Ties broken by Sort than Gather. (see area diagrams above)

- SHEEP**
- Starts with all gates closed, small amount of grain in feed bunker and stock in Pen 2
- Pen #1 – Move stock from Pen 2 to Arena, call dog off and go to cone for 10 pts
- Gather – Dog must leave from cone to gather stock to Chute entrance area for 20 pts  
Advanced handler must stay at cone until dog is sent  
Open handler may move up halfway to stock
- Chute – Move stock into Chute and hold for inspection, release into Arena and move stock to Pen 2 gate for 20 pts  
Advanced handler sprays for parasites  
Open handler inspects stock
- Sort – Sort 3 marked head into Pen 2 (sort direction at handler's discretion), reunite all stock in Pen 2 for 25 pts
- Pen #2 – Move stock from Pen 2 to Pen 3 for 5 pts
- This portion finishes with stock in Pen 3 and all gates including chute front and back closed

- DUCKS**
- Starts with all gates closed, small amount of grain in feed pan and stock in Pen A
- Pen #3 – Move stock from Pen A to Arena for 5 pts
- Additional Task #1 – Move stock thru Footbath and exhaust to Pen D for 20 pts  
Advanced handler stays behind Footbath exit until stock is by Pen D  
Open handler may move anywhere
- Pen #4 – Move stock from Pen D to Pen C for 5 pts
- Additional Task #2 – Move Crate into Pen area and load stock into Crate for 20 pts
- Finishes with stock in Crate and all gates closed
